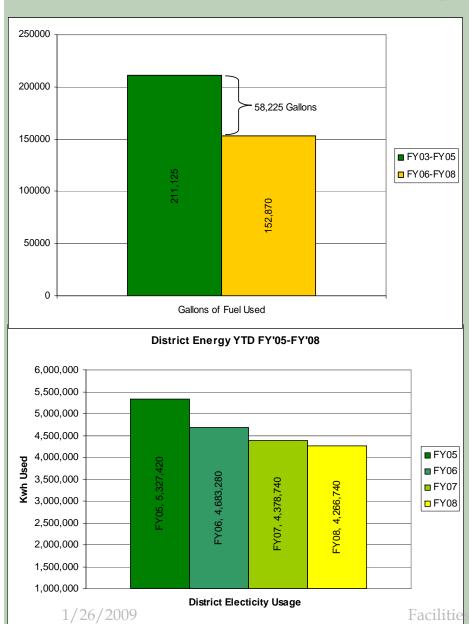

Current Facilities Goals

- New energy initiatives are under way
 - Lighting retrofits in 4 gyms
 - Role out of behavior based plan
 - 3-4% reduction on top of prior savings
- Evaluation of current custodial practices
 - Gaining productivity with work loading analysis
 - Additional training and responsibilities for head custodians
 - Development of custodial handbooks
 - Standardizing chemicals and practices
- Review and evaluation of policies and compliance
