#### Year in review accomplishments

- Improved student achievement, meeting AYP in all categories in ELA except one (special education subgroup) and in all categories in math for grades 3, 4, and 5.
- Introduced and trained staff in the use of AIMSweb as an effective assessment tool for benchmarking and progress monitoring.
- Developed and introduced a "Response to Intervention" plan that blends high quality instruction with evidence based interventions meeting individual needs and maximizing achievement for all students.
- Established a team that investigated scientifically based interventions for ELA and Math providing an excellent resource for staff to help address individual needs of students.

#### Accomplishments (Cont.)

- Through the collaboration of the Vertical Team and with the help of Department of Teaching & Learning a study skills and test taking "sweep" was implemented in each classroom.
- Increased the home-school connection by providing resources for parents that include the use of technology to support all academic areas and test taking strategies, Family Math and Reading nights, and Parent Forums.
- Fine tuned an effective plan for evacuation and lockdown that will assure the safety of all students and staff.
- Sponsored the MRE Summer Theater Camp for children in grades 3-5.
- Continued to provide an environment where children strive for and value high achievement while feeling safe and having fun.
