## **Organizational Scope:**

This position reports directly to the Director of Pupil Personnel Services with indirect report to the Superintendent as the appointing authority. The work of the Occupational Therapist is influenced by NRSD's core values of academic achievement and personal growth; voice, choice and agency; lifelong learning; a safe, caring and inclusive community; collaborative partnerships; innovation; and a sense of belonging for all.

## Position Responsibilities:

- Supports instructional programming by providing occupational therapy to students as required.
- Consults with staff to meet the needs of all students requiring occupational therapy
- Implements therapeutic plans
- Schedules students into appropriate instructional groups
- Assists with mobility, transitioning and personal care as needed
- Other duties as assigned

## Job Qualifications & Physical Demands:

Must be licensed as Occupational Therapist. Must have excellent communication and interpersonal skills and possess a high level of capability with technology. Classroom experience and college degree required. Must be able to assist in the protection of students and school property, assist the principal in fire and other emergency drills as required by law and School Committee policy.
