It is the responsibility of the Nashoba Regional School District to identify any child who may have a disability who is either a resident of Nashoba Regional School District or who attends a private school within the geographic boundaries of Nashoba Regional School District even if the student is not a resident of Nashoba Regional School District. This also includes students who are homeschooled.

Nashoba Regional School District is also responsible for the evaluation of those students to determine if they are eligible for special education or related services under Federal law, IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act) or, Massachusetts State Law, 603 CMR 28 (Massachusetts Special Education Regulations).

Nashoba Regional School District is also committed to identifying children before their third birthday in order to provide early intervention services for three and four year-olds with disabilities. If you have questions or concerns regarding your child's development and would like to have him/her screened, please call our office at 978-779-0539 x3012 to set up an appointment.
